## HELENE REBUILDING EFFORTS UPDATE

Dear Mount Vernon Baptist Church,

For the past fifteen months five Baptist on Mission rebuild centers have been equipping, housing, feeding and sending out volunteers to serve the people of western North Carolina impacted by Hurricane Helene. Rebuild Centers in East Flat Rock, Swannanoa, Burnsville, Spruce Pine and here in Boone have completed 663 Helene home rebuilds. 262 are in progress and 20 new homes have been approved for construction.

Our Boone Rebuild office covers Ashe, Avery and Watauga (and Wilkes & Johnson, Tn). We have completed 103 home repairs and have 19 homeowners we are currently serving. We have one new home construction that is nearing completion in West Jefferson and we are about to begin construction on a new home in Banner Elk.

Here in Boone we've had almost 2,200 volunteers come help us serve the families in our area. They have ranged in age from teenagers to a 92 yr old retired church

organist. Some were knowledgeable and skilled in construction, and some didn't know which end of a hammer to hold. But all came to be a blessing and serve the people of the High Country.

We are especially grateful to the Rutherfordwood Baptist Church Family for their willingness to be a big part of the Boone Rebuild Team. They are gracious to let us use their church as our volunteer housing center. **We are also thankful for the continued support and involvement of the Mount Vernon Baptist Church family!** You, along with several other churches in our association, have been willing to feed and take care of our volunteers. We are thankful to God for all who have been and continue to be a part of this ministry.

*We echo the prayer of Paul as he said, "I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now." (Phil 1:3-5)*
