Church Family,

This Sunday we'll continue our journey through Colossians looking at Colossians 1:18–20. What a powerful reminder that Jesus is not only the Head of the Church, but that He alone holds first place in everything. He is the One who reconciles, restores, and brings peace through the blood of His cross.

As we focus on Christ's headship over His Church, we also want to lean into His heart for the harvest.

In Luke 10:2, Jesus tells His disciples, "...The harvest is abundant, but the workers are few. Therefore, pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into his harvest."

This is not just a verse to read — it's a command to obey. So we're calling our church to a daily prayer emphasis beginning Monday, February 16th and going through our Night of Worship on Sunday, February 22nd.

We're asking everyone to set an alarm for 10:02 AM each day as a reminder to stop and pray Luke 10:2. Wherever you are — at work, at home, at school, or on the road — pause and ask the Lord to raise up and send out laborers for His harvest —beginning with you!

If you're available, you're also invited to come by the church sanctuary to pray, or to join others in a prayer walk around the church campus during that time. Imagine the unity and power of our church family lifting the same prayer to the Lord every single day. Jesus is the Head of the Church, let's pray boldly and watch what He will do in each of us.


Prayer in the sanctuary.
