Dear Mt Vernon Church Family

Attached is a 3 Day Prayer request from your Pastor Search Committee. We are taking our task very seriously and we know that on our own, we cannot accomplish anything! It is only by God's grace that our new pastor will make his way to Mt. Vernon. We need your help! We will take time each day to pray with you!

Attached is a 3 Day Prayer list. The first 10 days concentrate on praying for the Search Committee. Days 11 through 21 focus on MVRH - as a congregation and the final 10 days focus on the man God is calling, even now, to be our next Senior Pastor.

We are asking you to pray through it for 30 days and then start over. We may periodically ask you to pray for other things as well. God calls and we cannot come fully to Him and He will respond to our humble heart. We need you Mount Vernon, to pray and seek God with us! We believe He has a very good plan ahead for us!

Prayer for Search Committee

Day 1: Pray for deep spiritual cleansing and fullness of the Holy Spirit in each member and that their hearts are humble and teachable. Antonio Ariza, Joe W. Greene, Kevin Howard, Al Houck, Jerry Phillips, Josh Phillips, Kim Shields, Deniece Smith, Amy Wilson, Jonathan Liskertsen (alternates: Ps. 51:10-12,17; Ps. 138:2-4; Is. 66:1-2; Eph. 5:15-21; John 15:4-5).

Day 2: Pray for God to fill the chairman, Al Houck, and the Committee, with knowledge of His will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding and for strength to walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him. Pray that the Committee be earnest in seeking the Lord in prayer. Luke 6:12-13; Mt. 6:6-13; 1 Thess. 5:16-22; Gal. 1:3-12; Philippians 9:11; 2:14-6; Ps. 127:1.

Day 3: Pray for powerful unity and oneness in spirit within the Committee. Amos 3:3; Eph. 4:1-3.

Day 4: Pray for God's clear direction in how resumes are examined and interviews conducted. Ask God to bring His chosen man to the attention of the Committee. Ja. 1:5; Is. 55:8-9; Rom. 10:2.

Day 5: Pray for the Search Committee to have God's wisdom in all questions and information they share with the prospective pastor with Spirit-led thoroughness being essential. 1 Cor. 2:10-16; Ps. 137:1-11.

Day 6: Pray for the Committee to have wisdom and discernment regarding the unique characteristics and traits God has planned for any man called for MVRH as a pastor. 1 Cor. 15:1-11; Ja. 1:9-4.

Day 7: Pray for the Committee to have only God's timetable, and no other, in their determination to find God's perfect will in God's perfect time. Eph. 1:17; 5:15-17; Jer. 29:11-13; Is. 55:8-9.

Day 8: Pray that any influence of Satan will be thwarted. That any attempt to mislead or catch or deceive the Committee will be completely hindered. Pray for a powerful hedge of protection around the Committee and their families. John 10:1-5,11; Acts 20:29-30; Eph. 6:10-13.

Day 9: Pray for God's guidance in how the future pastor will be presented to the church. Pray that there would be no hint of division - only complete unity among the Committee and the church. 1 Cor. 1:10; Philippians 1:27; 2:13-15.

Day 10: Pray that the Pastor Search Committee will seek God's will for the church above their own desires. That they are diligent and work hard to fulfill the task entrusted to them. Gal. 3:23; Gal. 6:9-10; Rom. 12:11; John 13:13-17; Philippians 2:3-11.

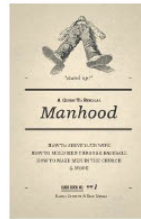

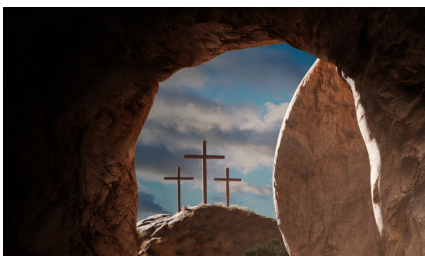

MVBC Christian Education Scholarship Application

Scholarship Requirements

To be considered, the applicant must meet all of the criteria outlined below.

The applicant must be:

1. A member or affiliate member of MVBC; and
2. Completing ministry-based undergraduate and/or graduate-level coursework for a degree(s) that clearly leads to formal employment in Christian ministry; and
3. Seeking such ministry-based education and/or degree from a Christian institution of higher learning (i.e., seminary, Bible college or institute). The institution shall be one that meets with the Mount Vernon Baptist Church's doctrinal statement. For more information, reference the Baptist Faith and Message (2000).

Note: Additional information may be requested for verification purposes including, but not limited to transcripts, an institution's statement of beliefs, references, etc.

Current Timelines for Consideration

Fully completed applications must be submitted by the following dates:

March 31, 2025 - for Fall (and Summer) semester consideration

November 1, 2025 for Spring semester 2026 consideration
