We live in a broken world with a broken system, but Christ came to overcome this world. He has called us to be ambassadors to it, to shine His Light and Love to it. The month of May is Foster Care Awareness Month, and we want to highlight the efforts in our community to support and heal the brokenness.

Foster Connection is a local nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting children and families involved in the foster care and adoption process. We provide essential items when a placement is made, including meals and resources that support the family. We also do community-building events to help families feel seen and know they are not alone. In Watauga County, we have 44 children in foster care, and 30 licensed foster homes to care for these children. As a result of our lack of available homes, 27 children were placed outside of Watauga County. 




