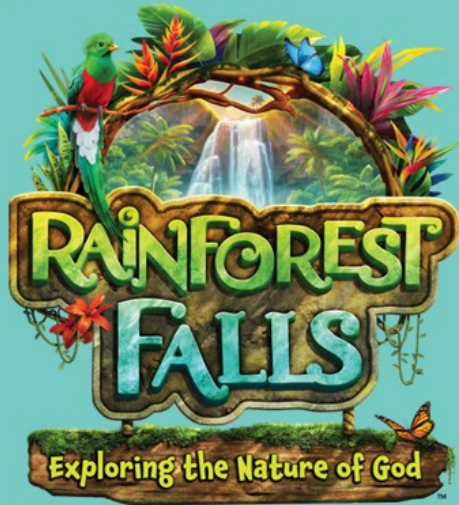
As a church family, let's commit ourselves to three simple actions:

- Serve as an individual or with a group

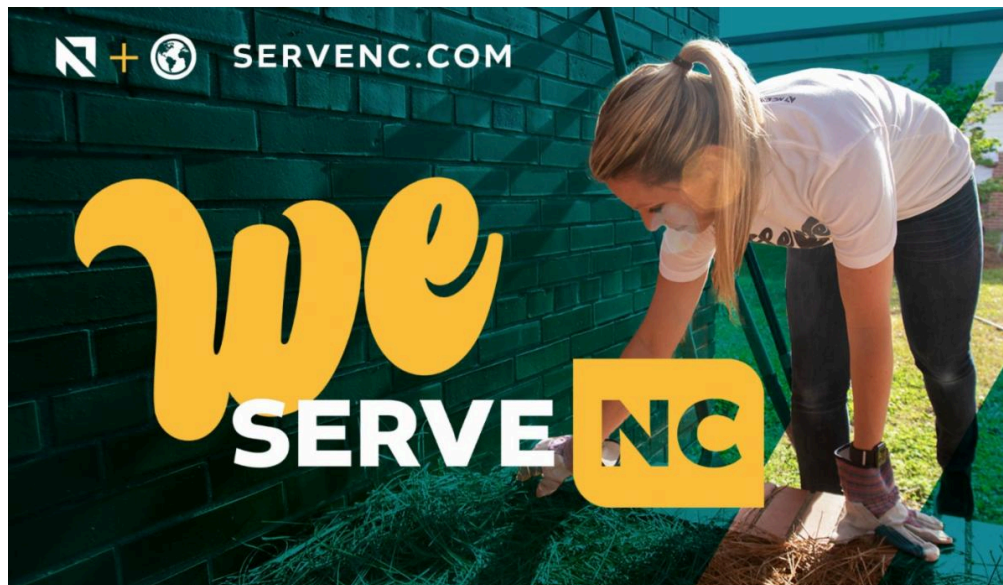

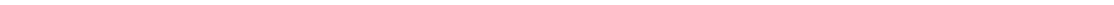
