ELDER & DEACON NOMINATIONS

We are excited to announce that the Elder and Deacon nomination process is now open! We encourage you to prayerfully consider nominating a fellow member of our church who meets the following qualifications as specified in our Bylaws:

ELDERS

Qualifications: Mount Vernon Baptist Church selects Elders from its male members who meet the biblical qualifications and high standards required for the office. By God's grace, they strive to live and serve in full accordance with the standards outlined in Hebrews 13:17, 1 Timothy 3:1-7, 1 Peter 5:1-3, and Titus 1:5-9. The Senior Pastor serves as an ex officio voting member of the Elders. Paid staff may serve as Elders only if the Senior Pastor or Senior Interim Pastor is absent. Each Elder must be ordained before assuming his role. The Personnel Section of the Operations Manual may list additional responsibilities.

The Church will have a minimum of seven Elders serving at any time, including the Senior Pastor.

DEACONS

Qualifications: There shall be a minimum of 10 active deacons. All Deacons shall be elected from the male members of Mt. Vernon Baptist Church. By God's grace, they will strive to live and serve according to the biblical standards for their office, as outlined in 1 Timothy 3:8-13.

We recommend that you only nominate men who have been members of Mount Vernon for at least three years. And please let your nominee know you are putting their name forward for consideration.

The deadline for nominations is July 27

Submit nominations by using the form linked below or completing the paper form available in the church's main office.

Please submit your name with your nomination; anonymous submissions will not be considered, as nominations for these roles are made by members of Mount Vernon.


